### Did You Know?

### A Local Agency You May Not Know:

Opportunity Knocks is an organization that works with people with developmental disabilities in Forest Park, Oak Park and River Forest. They are located in the River Forest Community Center on Madison Street. They offer recreation, fitness and self-advocacy programs.

### Changes in Housing for Adults with Developmental Disabilities

The Illinois Council on Developmental Disabilities (ICDD) is looking to change the face of housing for the developmentally disabled in the state and offer more options. They would like to assist communities to create new supportive housing opportunities, and \$12 million was awarded to the Illinois Housing Development Authority to help make this happen. ICDD, in conjunction with a nonprofit called Corporation For Supported Housing (CSH), wants to work with consumers and families to raise awareness of resources, advocate to ensure that the developmental disability system is positioned to take advantage of existing resources and encourage the willingness of providers, family members and self-advocates to push for what the population needs.

Housing would be provided in apartments and single family homes, and support services such as case management, social work and other services would be provided as the individual requests. The apartments would be in buildings with less than 25% of the residents needing supportive services. The rest of the residents would be typical renters. This would encourage more community integration than the current CILA (Community Integrated Living Arrangement) model now provides.

The agency is working with CSH to train agencies on how to implement this model. Several local agencies are interested in working with the Supportive Housing Institute on this initiative.
