"Our guest columnist this issue is Gerry Beagles. Gerry is Executive Director of Garden Center Services (GCS)."

Garden Center Services was established in 1956 as Garden School for the Handicapped by parents who felt their children deserved more than Illinois institutions had to offer. In 1976, GCS responded to the changing needs of our population by modifying the school classrooms into an adult vocational center where the program participants receive essential life skills training and also take part in meaningful paid work opportunities. In 1990 we expanded our array of services to include residential supports by building the agency's first residential alternative, offering individuals an opportunity to live fulfilling lives in their community.

Today, GCS provides community living for 77 adults with disabilities in 14 homes throughout the Chicagoland area. GCS also provides vocational, volunteer, learning, and social opportunities for 150 adults with disabilities at three day-programming centers. We now have two alternative program offerings in which the participants spend most of their day contributing to their communities by volunteering in such projects as delivering "Meals on Wheels," baking at the Ronald McDonald house, cleaning up litter from local parks and assisting with activities at the village senior center.

Our agency's mission statement:

"Garden Center Services is committed to supporting and empowering persons with developmental disabilities through innovative and personcentered services. Our commitment to the excellence of our programs is surpassed only by our devotion to the people we serve and the communities in which they live."

In our effort to live up to this commitment when the funding for our services is inadequate, GCS has developed a number of businesses to both generate additional revenue and provide our consumers with meaningful engagement.
